Teams' preparation (MD-1)

- Familiarising the stadium
- Sharpness (physical preparation)
- 11 v 11 game (tactical preparation)
- Finishing (1-2s, crosses, free-kicks)

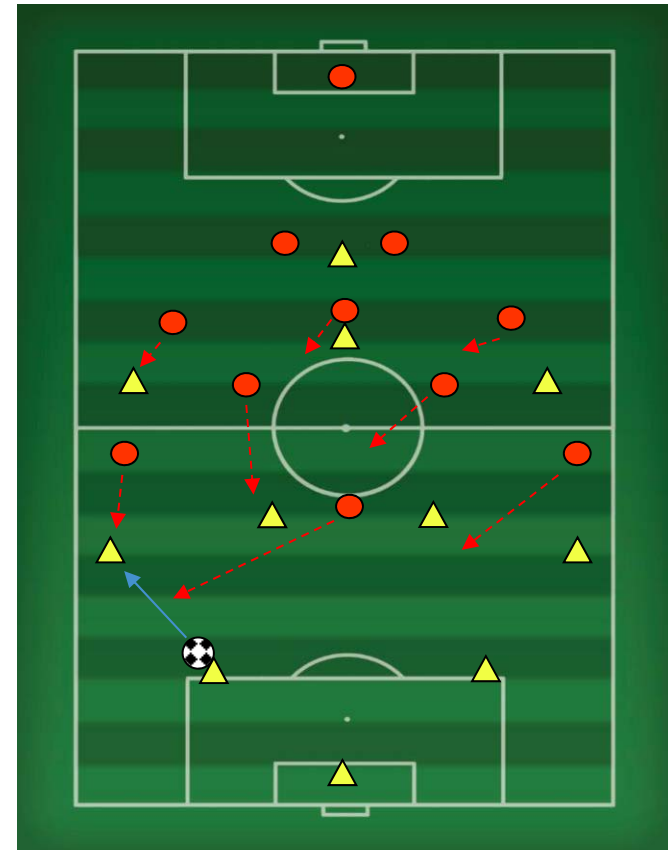
1. Semi-high pressing
2. Tight defensive unit – high / low
3. Number of balancing players when attacking: 3 / 4

Tactical & Technical findings

Semi-high pressing

- Withdraw to the center circle
- Backline high
- Invite opponent to open play to defenders
- Strong press once pass into midfield
- Space behind opponent's defense



Tactical & Technical findings

Tight defensive unit – low / high

- Low – no space behind defense
- High – win the ball higher

**Number of balancing players
when attacking: 3 / 4**

Making overloads in attacking third

- Fullback + winger
- Winger + centre forward + midfielder
- Winger + winger
